Nathan Heuer Fund—Last Call

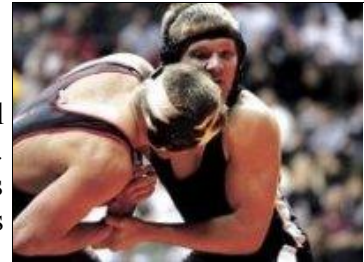
Nathan Heuer, a 2009 graduate of Roosevelt High School continues his battle with a rare form of cancer called Lymphoblastic lymphoma. Nate excelled throughout his high school career in football and wrestling, being recognized as an All Conference Selection in football in 2008 and was a state champion wrestler in 2008.

Nate is responding well to treatments but faces a tough year ahead dealing with chemotherapy treatments and a bone marrow transplant this Summer. The RHS Alumni Association has started a fund to benefit Nate and assist with medical expenses his family will incur in the coming months. 100% of all donations will go to the Heuer family.
